A joint effort – 2017 to 2018


- The Norwegian Police

- Residence permits
 - fingerprints from the age of 6
- Schengen Visa
 - fingerprints from the age of 12
- Protection (asylum)
 - fingerprints from the age of 14
- § 100 Immigration Act






Architecture
